Benefits of SSO

Available for all eligible School Food Authorities (SFAs) participating in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP)



With State Agency approval, SFAs may sponsor non-school sites



SFA provides **Free Meals** to children 18 years of age and younger



Additional 6 cents for every lunch served



Additional commodity entitlement for every lunch served



Second breakfast can be claimed

More Benefits

Same meal pattern as NSLP, including Offer vs. Serve



No edit check required



Simplified Claim Process



Field Trip notification not required

SITE ELIGIBILITY

For a closed enrolled site, the eligibility is determined annually based on the enrolled participation.



For an area eligible site, the eligibility continues for 5 years!

WHAT ELSE?

Camp and Migrant sites may claim up to three meals per day



Supper may be served in place of lunch
