Job Goal: The School Nutrition Director oversees the daily progress of the school nutrition program. The administrator is responsible for planning, implementing, and evaluating the school nutrition department. The School Nutrition Director is required to meet the nutritional needs of the children, and is responsible for supporting healthy food habits, providing well balanced meals while overseeing staff at each school and ensuring customer satisfaction.

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent educational experience, with academic major in food and nutrition, food service management, dietetics, family and consumer sciences, nutrition education, culinary arts, business, or a related field, and at least 8 hours of food safety training either not more than 5 years prior to the starting date or completed within 30 days of employee start date.

- Responsible for the school nutrition budget
- Periodically report to the Board of Education
